We want to thank all of you for your faithful partnership with Child Evangelism Fellowship of Eastern Pennsylvania, Inc. Without you, we could not continue reaching children in Eastern PA with the good news of the Gospel. It would take many pages to share with you the countless stories of children's lives being changed this year! We are especially excited about the recent increase in parents responding to the Gospel alongside their children. Many lives and family legacies have been changed for eternity this year.

Again, this would not have been possible without you. It is difficult to find words to express our heartfelt gratitude for each of you in your faithfulness in giving to our Lord. **So far this year, 9,682 children have been reached with the Gospel, with 400 of them making professions of faith.** Thank you for your prayers, faithfulness, and commitment to reaching children for Jesus Christ.

Our goal moving into 2023 and beyond is to reach children of all cultures in Pennsylvania by hiring multicultural staff to share the Gospel in at least three different languages throughout the counties. **In our Philadelphia County chapter, we have hired two young men, Lucas and Elajah, to be missionaries to the children of the city.** We are excited about these newer staff members and would like to introduce them to you.

Lucas Quiroz Cuevas grew up in the country of Argentina and speaks two languages fluently. He was a summer missionary with us for five years and has recently taken a new position as Assistant Director in Philadelphia County. We are also excited to introduce Elajah Gijsbertha, who came on staff with us this past summer. Elajah was born in the Netherlands but grew up in Curaçao. He is fluent in three languages: English, Spanish, and Dutch. He is working in Philadelphia as our Software Engineer.
