Every day as children, my three siblings and I would sit in our dining room to eat, feet dangling, gazing at the framed photo hung there above the table. For my entire life, the same photo hung in the same place on the wall. It pictures a white-haired man sitting beside his Bible and a loaf of bread. The man's head is bowed in quiet prayer.



Former director Mable Ruth Wray gifted the print to my parents many years ago, and it represents a legacy of prayer and faithfulness with an impact too vast to even calculate. While cleaning out my mother's house earlier this year, my siblings and I decided that the photo should go back to where it came from—CEF State Headquarters, in Mable Ruth's former office.

While this photo, which I learned is called, "Grace," may have not caused me a second thought as a child, as an adult, I realize its deep value and what it represents in my life and my family.
